

Dr. Ian Beasley is a consultant in Sport and Exercise Medicine and a foundation fellow of the faculty of SEM in the UK. He has worked in football since 1987, and at 4 EPL clubs including Arsenal and Chelsea, as well as the England national team, attending two senior and one under-21 world cups as team physician. At this time he was chief medical officer at the English FA and member of the UEFA medical committee.

He was CMO for English and Great Britain field hockey for ten years and attended two Olympics and Commonwealth Games as team physician. He was Team GB headquarters medical officer in 2012. He was medical adviser to the Royal Ballet London, and Senior Lecturer at the Centre for SEM at Queen Mary College, University of London, and medical consultant to the global performance unit at Manchester City FC.

After working as a sports medicine physician at Aspetar Hospital in Qatar, he returned to the UK to resume his role with the Royal Ballet, continue in his role with Manchester City, and is due to attend the FIFA Arab Cup as venue medical officer later this year.
